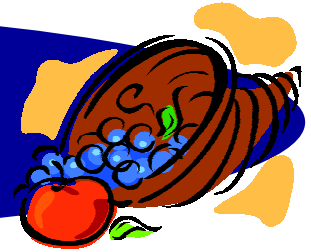

Welcome Back, President Denny!

Lynn Kellogg, wife of **John Kellogg**, gave the program. She talked about her hobby of making pottery. She said that she learned all about it from local sources, right here in Reedley. Lynn took a class at Reedley College from Jim Gregory and later a class at Reedley Adult School. The schools have all the wheels, kilns and other equipment that is needed. The students only have to pay for the clay in the Adult School class. Lynn spoke of two types of pottery: high-fire pottery and low-fire pottery. Only the high-fire pottery is dishwasher safe and oven safe. Lynn described how she “throws” the clay onto the wheel and shapes it. She then does a first fire, glazes it, and

then does a second firing. She brought several very nice examples of work that she has done. Thanks, Lynn.

Also last week, **Robert Huebert** gave a report on the auction pre-planning meeting that was recently held. He said that promotional posters are coming out this week and tickets will be out soon. ### This Week ~ January 31




